Treasure's Report: We have \$15,635.41 in our checking account. We still owe the state money from Horse Trailer ticket sales, they are supposed to send statements soon. Marritt is working on invoices for fees owed from last year.

Auction took in \$12,464.75 – owe 10% to auctioneer for fees.

Jon Moser went over stall and camping format, he will want these forms e-mailed to him at chevman64@aol.com **No later than 1 week prior to the meet.** He will contact each coach on Saturday of our meets to verify the number of stalls and camp sites each team has used. Invoices will be sent out by e-mail the next week.

There was discussion about charging a fee for entering a cattle event. Cattle charges are about \$6,000. each year. Several districts in the state charge a fee to help offset this big expense. Most coaches felt they would rather pay higher district fees than pay a cattle charge.
